Proposed Legislation for 2013	The Board selected the following for their 2012 Legislative Proposals: 1. CME proposal that would allow specific requirements for CME be set by the Board in rule in lieu of statute. 2. CME on Domestic Violence proposal would change the current requirement to complete this course every six years. 3. Increase fine caps proposal which would increase fines in certain offenses to \$25,000. 4. Streamlining the licensure process without an increase in fee cap.
New Legislation Enacted in 2012	<u>Enrolled CS/CS/HB 787, Engrossed 1 – Controlled Substance Prescribing and Pain Management Clinics</u> Section 31 of this bill amends section 456.44, Florida Statutes (F.S.), the registration and standard of practice requirements for health care practitioners who prescribe controlled substances for the treatment of chronic nonmalignant pain. Sections 32 and 33 of the bill amend sections 458.3265 and 459.0137, F.S., with regard to Pain Management Clinics. The provisions of this law become effective July 1, 2012. <u>Enrolled CS/CS/CS/HB 1263 – Liposuction</u> Sections 94 and 95 of this bill amend sections 458.309 and 459.005, F.S., with regard to the performance of certain liposuction procedures. This requirement is effective January 3, 2013. <u>Other related bills that passed include:</u> Enrolled CS/CS/HB119, Engrossed 3 - Personal Injury Protection Enrolled CS/CS/CS/HB 363, Engrossed 1 - Physician Assistants Enrolled CS/CS/HB 653 - Health Care Fraud Enrolled CS/CS/CS/HB 1355, Engrossed 2 - Expert Witness Testimony Enrolled HB 7035 - Physician Workforce Surveys
Creation of New Committee	Communication, Education and Information Committee - This committee is tasked with developing proactive communication strategies in an effort to education and inform applicants, licensees and the public about the role of the Board of Medicine and the laws and rules regulating the practice of medicine.

Rule Amendments for FY 11-12

During FY 11-12, the Board drafted new rules and amended several existing rules in a continued effort to improve the quality of health care, increase patient safety, and to increase the efficiency of the Board. Some rule highlights are noted below:

Board of Medicine Rules:

This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-1.007, FAC – Forms, Incorporated
This rule was amended to incorporate changes in application forms.
- Rule 64B8-2.002, FAC – General Supervision
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-2.003, FAC – Use of Acupuncture
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-3.009, FAC – Unlicensed Activity Fee
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-4.009, FAC – Applications
This rule was amended to incorporate changes in application forms.
- Rule 64B8-4.016, FAC – Endorsement Application Deadline
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-4.029, FAC – Registration as a Dispensing Physician
This rule was amended to incorporate changes in the Dispensing Physician Application form.
- Rule 64B8-5.004, FAC – Examination Application Deadline
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.

This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.

Rule Amendments for FY 11-12

- Rule 64B8-8.005, FAC – Prescriptions to Correct Refractive Errors
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-8.008, FAC – Random Blood and Urine Testing
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-8.015, FAC – Mediation
This rule was amended to set forth additional offenses which are appropriate for mediation.
- Rule 64B8-8.017, FAC – Citation Authority
This rule was amended to set forth additional offenses which are appropriate for issuance of a citation.
- Rule 64B8-9.007, FAC – Standards of Practice (Pause Rule)
This rule was amended to require another health care practitioner to verify the procedure/patient/site in an effort to reduce the number of wrong patient/wrong site/wrong procedures.
- Rule 64B8-9.005, FAC – HIV/AIDS: Knowledge of Antibody Status; Action to be Taken
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-9.0075, FAC – Standards of Practice in Certain Office Settings
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-9.010, FAC – Interpretation of Diagnostic Imaging Tests or Procedures
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-9.011, FAC – Itemized Patient Billing
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.
- Rule 64B8-9.0134, FAC – Maximum Number of Prescriptions in Registered Pain Management Clinics
This rule was withdrawn when statutory authority was removed from the Board.
- Rule 64B8-9.017, FAC – Optional Informed Consent for Cataract Surgery
This rule was created in response to new legislation that required the Board to create an informed consent form for optional use by ophthalmologists. This rule incorporates the form by reference.
- Rule 64B8-13.005, FAC – Continuing Education for Biennial Renewal
This rule was amended to incorporate the newly established five most mis-diagnosed medical conditions from the previous two years.
- Rule 64B8-13.007, FAC – Continuing Education Credits for Physicians Volunteering for FMLE Comparison Study
This rule was found to be unnecessary and was repealed.

Rule Amendments for FY 11-12

Physician Assistant Rules:

- Rule 64B8-30.003, FAC – Physician Assistant Licensure
This rule was amended due to a technical issue related to clarifying a statutory reference.
- Rule 64B8-30.015, FAC – Disciplinary Guidelines
This rule was amended to remove references to community service.

Anesthesiology Assistant Rules:

- Rule 64B8-31.010, FAC – Disciplinary Guidelines
This rule was amended to clarify FME disciplinary guidelines by deleting language which was no longer applicable.

Other Related Rules:

- Rule 64B8-35.001, FAC – Purpose
This rule was found to be unnecessary and repealed (related to ARNP's).

Office Surgery Registration and Inspection Program Rules (Department)

- Rule 64B8-9.009, FAC – Standards of Care for Office Surgery
This rule was amended to set the number of years a physician practicing in an office surgery setting must maintain the surgical logs (6 years). This rule was also amended to remove the requirement for ampules of dantrolene; however, this part of the rule is still being reviewed by the Surgical Care Committee.
- Rule 64B8-9.0092, FAC – Approval of Physician Office Accrediting Organizations
The Board approved the Institute of Medical Quality as a board-approved accrediting organization in 2010 for a period of one year ending on July 14, 2011. This rule was amended to remove this organization as an accredited organization.

Pain Management Clinic Registration and Inspection Program Rules

- Rule 64B8-9.0131, FAC – Training Requirements for Physicians Practicing in Pain Management Clinics
This rule was amended to clarify the time frame for completion of the 40 hour course as July 1, 2012, in compliance with law.

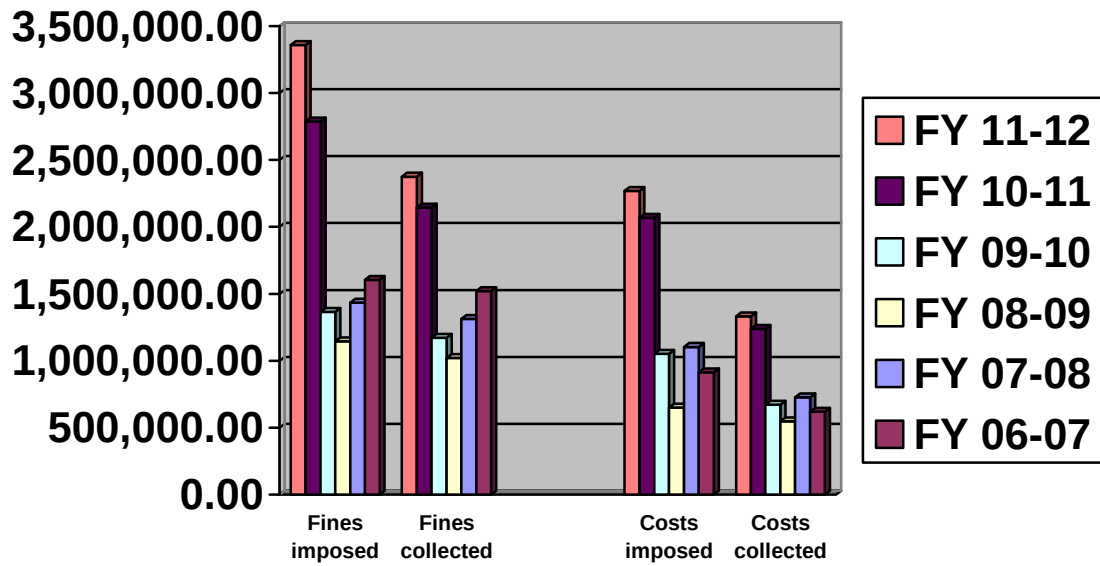

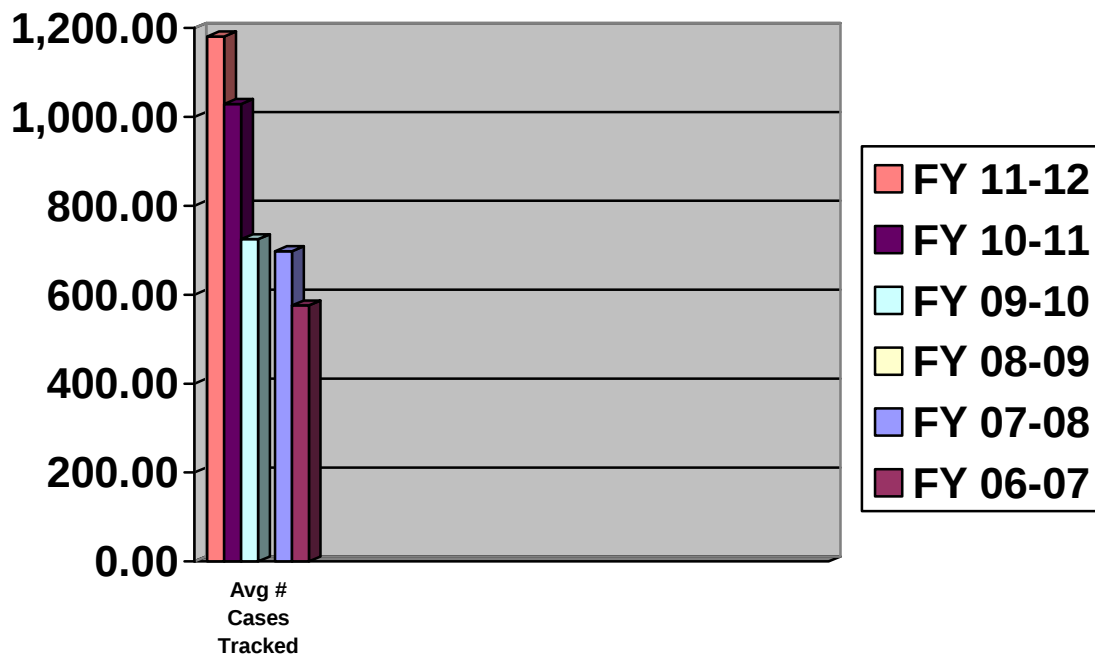
